- Loudmouth is an innovative theatre in education company. Since 1994 Loudmouth has provided a wide range of programmes and formats to support schools' and colleges' Personal, Social, Health and Economic education.
- Loudmouth uses drama performances and interactive workshops to complement your safeguarding and relationship, sex and health education curriculum.
- Loudmouth has all permanent staff who are fully safeguarding trained and are skilled in working in a range of environments with children and young people of all ages, needs, abilities and backgrounds.
- Loudmouth's work aims to support all children and young people to have a healthy, happy and safe future. We have been running for nearly 30 years, and aren't going to let a pandemic stop us!

COVID-19 Update

Loudmouth has been safely working throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. We used the time to create pre-recorded versions of our performances for teachers to play to their pupils in the classroom. We have also adapted our offices into studios, where we now run our virtual workshops that follow up the filmed dramas. As the new school year starts, we will continue to follow government advice (Department for Education and Public Health England), local council guidance and work with each school's COVID policy and procedures to ensure that we are running our programmes as safely as possible. The safety of our staff and the staff and pupils in the schools and colleges we visit, is our priority.





We have adapted our programmes and work practices to ensure the safety of all involved. Here are some of our COVID safety measures:

- Each session is risk assessed and will accommodate each venue's COVID safety measures.
- Flexible formats are available to schools and colleges including online options.
- Workshops are socially distanced and we can work with class bubbles.
- Twice weekly COVID testing of staff.

For this academic year 2021/22 we are offering all our schools and colleges the flexibility to book our theatre in education programmes in whichever format best suits you.

With the uncertainty around COVID-19 and the restrictions that it brings, we are offering a range of formats so that your students can still participate in our sessions whatever happens. You can mix and match to your heart's content.

You can choose either...

LIVE

We run a live in-person performance with a year group followed by live in-person class sized workshops or a large group workshop.

or

VIRTUAL

Virtual sessions - you play the pre-recorded filmed drama we send and we then run virtual workshop that are live streamed to a class at a time or with a number of classes at a time.

or

MIX YOUR OWN

You can also have a blended mix of live and virtual - either a live performance followed by virtual workshops or watch the pre-recorded film followed by in-person workshops.



It is really up to you and what suits your school or college best. Plus if restrictions change and you want to swap from live to virtual or virtual to live, we can easily do that.
